

The interior room is more commodious, front and rear. The body is longer. The stance is the widest on the road today.





The Lincoln Continental Sedan. In these generous new proportions, each elegant hallmark of Continental design—
the sculptured hood, the graceful greenhouse, the sweeping rear deck—has become more dramatic.

And more apart from other cars. The headlamps are now concealed. New cornering lamps light the way for turns at night.



This luxurious interior choice features brocade and vinyl in a gracious wide-pleat and tie-button style.

Choose your brocade in light gold, medium brown, light aqua, medium gray and black. The carpeting is long shear 100% nylon. The door trim, luxurious puffed vinyl. Every significant front dimension has been increased—headroom, shoulder room, hiproom, and legroom. And a new semi-oval steering wheel (with rim blow horn) allows more space between wheel and driver.



All Continentals are equipped with power front disc brakes which provide safer, surer braking action under all driving conditions.

In wet weather, water is removed centrifugally to minimize loss of braking power due to dampness.

A new optional Sure-Track Brake system prevents sustained rear wheel lock-up on ice, snow or wet pavements. This computerized system automatically pumps and releases the brakes for improved directional stability.



This new instrument cluster places the most-often-read dials—fuel and temperature—closest to the driver's line of vision. There are warning lights for headlamp doors closed, low fuel and dual brake system malfunction and a seat belt reminder light. The glove compartment has been doubled in size to accommodate many more of your travel accessories.



The all-new tail assembly reflects this motorcar's total sculptured elegance. The rear deck louvers are the outlet for Continental's new Flow-Thru Ventilation system. Very quietly and evenly, this system passes up to 480 cubic feet of fresh outside air through the passenger compartment every minute, even with all the side windows closed. You have full control of the air flow by means of switches within easy reach.




A new and opulent knitted tricot nylon covers the seats in this interior design choice. It comes in dark blue, dark red, dark green, dark brown and black. Every Continental has fold-down armrests, front and rear.

For the front passenger, a reclining seat is available as an option. Or you may select individually adjustable front Twin Comfort Lounge Seats (in black tricot), with 6-way power control for the driver and a 2-way power control for the passenger.




Padded armrest on driver's door organizes switches (left to right) for window and door locks; four power windows; power seat control and remote-control outside mirror.

A lighted, concealed ashtray and an individual window control are designed into each of the three passenger armrests.



Continental's luggage compartment has a usable capacity of 18.1 cubic feet, fully carpeted.

An optional remote-control deck-lid release includes a trunk-open warning light on the instrument panel. The tire cover is also optional.




The warm glow of rich leather seating surfaces and extra deep cut pile carpeting keynote

Continental's Town Car Interior option. There is a selection of 10 color schemes to choose from.

The rear passenger compartment is even more spacious than previous Continentals.

The seats are deeper front to back, and the rear seat back is four inches higher for matchless sitting ease. Rear passenger legroom has also increased dramatically.



The Lincoln Continental Coupé. This 1970 version, like the sedan, is the quietest and most velvet riding of all Lincoln Continentals.

Its engine is a massive 460 cubic inch deep-breathing V-8. Wider doors afford easier entrance and exit.

For quicker access to the roomier rear compartment, an optional electric solenoid releases the seat backs when either door is opened.



The Continental Mark III. A classic in its own time.


Everything about this motorcar is distinctive: the graceful, low profile; the long hood; the short rear deck; the contemporary concealed headlamps.



Top-grain glove leather, tumbled in huge drums for exquisite softness, highlights the Mark III vinyl-with-leather interior option. It's available in light gold, dark brown, medium brown, light aqua, dark blue, dark red, black, medium gray, dark green and white. The seating surfaces and the center armrests are upholstered with high-polished matched hides.

The carpet is toe-deep 100% cut-pile nylon. The elegant insert above each door armrest is genuine walnut.









Mark III is the most authoritatively styled, decisively individual motorcar of this generation. Among its appointments and standard equipment, there are many, many items that have been offered for the first time in an American motorcar.

Notably, the Cartier chronometer,
Michelin steel belted radial ply tires, and the new Sure-Track Brake system.









Sure-Track Brake System

A new Sure-Track Brake System is standard equipment on Mark III. It is the most advanced automotive braking system in the world—the safer, straighter way to stop a car. This computer-controlled system improves braking stability by preventing sustained rear wheel lock-up on ice, snow or wet pavements. When the driver slams his brakes in a panic stop, Sure-Track's electronic monitors take over, automatically actuating and releasing the brakes until the car slows to 4 mph, or until the brakes are released by the driver.

Michelin Tires

For 1970, Michelin 225–15 steel belted, radial ply tires are standard equipment. Michelin guarantees these tires to give 40,000 miles of tread wear. (See details on page 16.) The unique steel cord and radial design of these imports puts an extra wide tread on the road for improved handling.

Cartier Clock

The Mark III timepiece, designed by the famous jeweler Cartier, is the first 5-jewel electronic chronometer in an American motorcar. Transistors actuate the gear movement by continuous pulsations to achieve twice the accuracy of ordinary car clocks. The Cartier chronometer is virtually silent because there is no re-wind spring to "click" every minute or so.

The Mark III instrument panel is recessed in a veneer of genuine walnut. The entire cluster is visored to eliminate sunlight glare. Each of the five pods is tilted 13° from vertical for easier reading. Mark III has red-needle gauges for fuel supply, oil pressure, alternator and coolant temperature readings. The steering wheel is a new semi-oval type with a rim blow control for the three-note Mark III horn.

Mark III's aft section is distinguished by its famous tire-cover rear-deck design, vertical taillamps, and a massive, uncluttered bumper. Mark III offers a choice of 27 exterior colors, including four optional high-metallic-content acrylic paints that give the Mark III a starry glow. Vinyl roofs are now available in black, white, dark blue, dark green or dark brown.


AM/FM Stereo Radio. One of 3 sound system choices. Includes a 24-transistor radio, a stereo receiver, 4 speakers and a power antenna. For the FM band, an indicator light signals the reception of a stereo broadcast, and the system automatically switches to stereo receiver operation.



Tilt steering wheel. Adjusts to five positions through a 30-degree arc, so any driver can select his most comfortable wheel angle. The tilt column has the same energy-absorbing and locking features as a fixed column.



Automatic Temperature Control.

This super-sophisticated air conditioning system holds to within a degree or two of a preselected temperature. It cools in summer and warms in winter, regardless of outside weather changes. The system also removes pollen and dust, dehumidifies, defogs and de-ices.
