



LINCOLN CONTINENTAL OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT

Speed control-helps reduce fatigue on long trips. You can activate the system, select the desired speed, accelerate, slow down, or disengage the system with just finger tip pressure.

Illuminated entry system-provides convenience and security. When either exterior front door button is pushed, interior lights and exterior door lock cylinder light are illuminated for approximately 20 seconds.

Power glass moonroof-lets you see out and the sun shine in. Even when closed. Includes an adjustable sun screen. Available in silver, gold, light jade, brown, or rosé tint.

Wide fixed glass moonroof-provides a reflective surface for almost the entire forward portion of the roof. Includes interior sliding sun screen.

Citizens band radio-keeps you in touch with home base or any CB'er along your trip. Ideal for businessmen or travelers, it comes complete with a power antenna. (License required to operate)

Tilt steering wheel-(not illustrated) adjusts to five positions for ease of entry, exit, and driving comfort.

Sure-Track brake system with 4-wheel disc brakes-(not illustrated) provides maximum braking modulation and fade resistance at each wheel, and helps prevent sustained rear wheel lock-up on ice, snow, or wet pavement (N/A Calif.).



Corresion Protection

In 1977, all Continentals will feature expanded use of precoated steel to provide additional corrosion protection in several major areas. They also will feature additional use of a sealer on the underside of the rear wheelhouses and the continued use of sealers for protection in the lower areas most susceptible to corrosion. These corrosion protection processes are in addition to a continued use of electrocoat first primer inside and outside of the body during the painting process.
